We would love to fill our calendar this Winter, Spring & Summer with opportunities to meet with you, share with your congregation, small group, or special focused organization about the work of Wycliffe Bible Translators.

We believe God has called us to join the effort of reaching the over 2,200 Bible-less language groups waiting for translation to begin and encourage the on-going work of over 1,100 languages where translation has begun so that it may be completed. It is our goal to support this work through Steve's skills in information technology as a computer programmer to enable 6,000+ missionaries around the world to stay on the field. Our service location would be at the Wycliffe Headquarters in Orlando, Florida and we are open to other locations in the USA and abroad as the Lord calls us to the various computer needs supporting the mission of Wycliffe. The translated Word is a foundation for every type of ministry: discipleship, evangelism, preservation of cultures, church planting, justice, education, community development and more.

It would be an honor and privilege to serve you in any of the following ways that would compliment what your current ministry emphasis is. We will be in contact with you in the near future to see if there would be a time you'd like us to meet with you further about this opportunity or if there is a date you'd already have in mind that would be fitting for us to schedule and come share with your congregation or group.

We realize that your budget has already been set for 2008 and you might not have the flexibility to partner with us financially on a regular basis. Yes, money is needed to further ministry, but we also see the importance of building relationships wherever the Lord leads us. Despite your financial situation, if you feel we'd be of encouragement in your ministry goals, we'd count it a joy to help individuals increase their awareness of God's work around the world and their part in the great commission in various ways. If you would consider us as missionaries to represent you in your 2008 budget plan, we would invite you to partner with us financially in this way, but this is not a requirement. So as the Lord calls, we trust Him to complete our support team. We are currently at 30% of the needed regular financial support.

Sunday Morning Worship Service

You set the time from 10 – 40 minutes of sharing as a couple or as a family through short stories, personal testimonies, special music, and audio visuals. If teaching time with a short sermon is needed, that can also be planned.

Sunday School

Adult Class – presentation similar to the Worship service with discussion time.

Youth Class – youth friendly object lessons, stories, awareness of mission opportunities as they make decisions in their education, and audio/video presentations.

Primary Grades – opening music if desired, object lessons, awareness of God using them as His children and how powerful their prayers are regarding missions.

Small Group or Home Meeting

This can be any evening of the week if that is what fits your schedule the best. These presentations are focused on the special interest of the group and the ages involved. We are flexible to engage all ages during the same meeting.

We are also open to multi-tasking, such as sharing during SS and Worship according to whatever fits with your Sunday morning worship and education schedule. We look forward to the possibility of getting to know you better!
